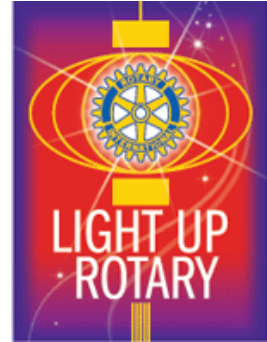

Hundreds of St Jude's students proudly celebrated Tanzanian, African and other nationalities at its recent Cultural Day at the Smith campus.

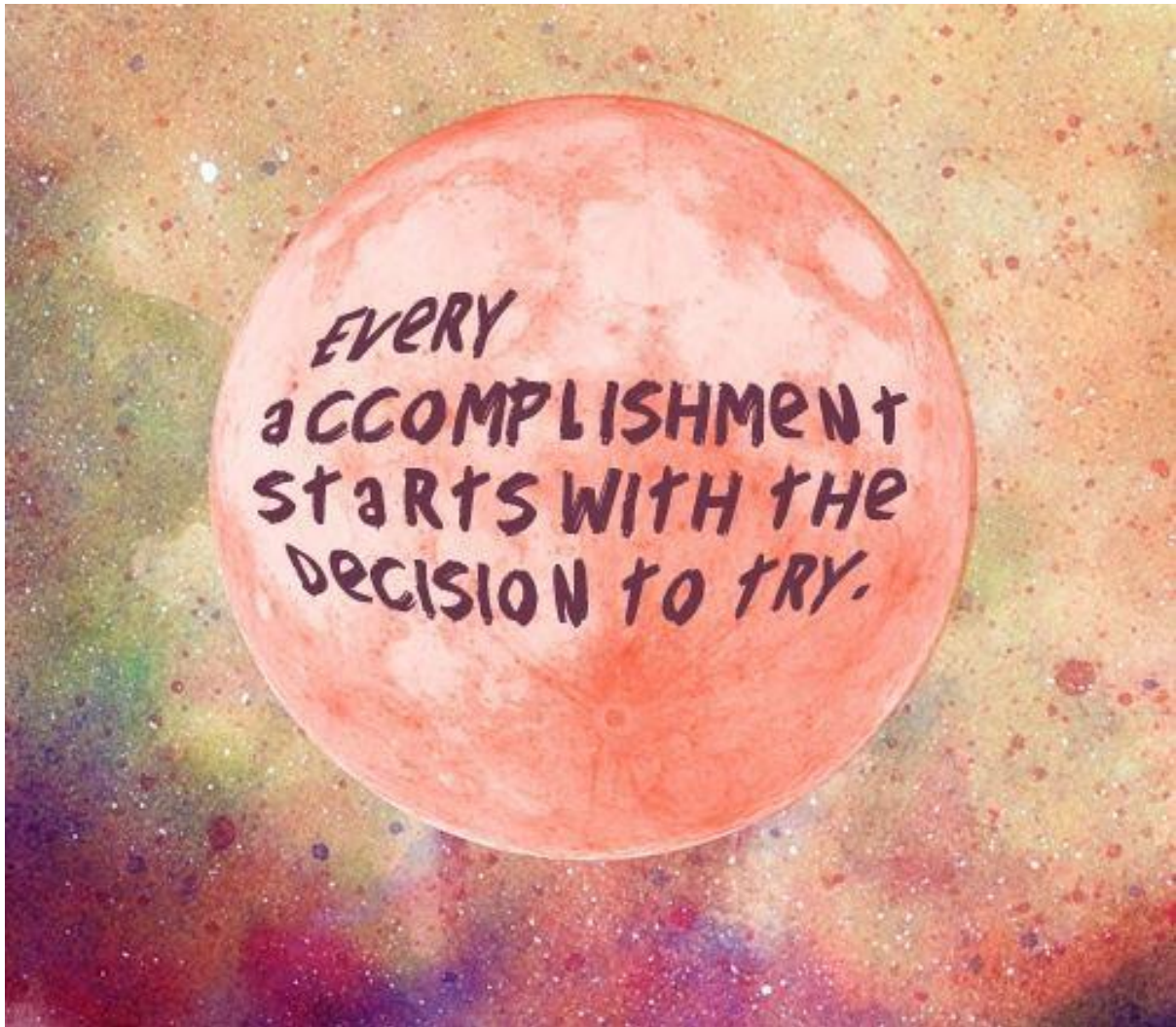
