3. Ian Durham on Vietnam



Tonight Ian gave a comprehensive talk on his tour of duty in Vietnam during the Vietnam War. We learned a lot about how the Australian Army engineers helped in this war. Ian was a sapper and drove heavy machinery clearing jungles. Ian left us with many statistics on this war and some salient ones are:

- Estimated overall casualties 5,773,190
- Estimated deaths 2,122,244
- Ammunition expended each day 71,000 tons.
- 10,000 artillery rounds expended each day
- The US flew 1,899,688 sorties and dropped 6,727,084 tons of bombs twice as much as was dropped in WW2 on Germany for the entire war.
- 503 Australian Diggers and 58,169 Americans lost their lives.
