



Ronald McDonald House Wagga Wagga opened in March 2005. The house is located at 300 Edward Street Wagga Wagga one

Deborah Braines (house manager) gave us a tour of the facilities and explained how the house works. They have a variety of families that use the house while the children or pregnant mothers receive treatment at one of Wagga's consulting rooms and the Wagga Wagga Base Hospital Dental Clinic. Ronald McDonald House provides a home away from home for families with sick or injured children, and expectant mothers, receiving medical treatment or attending medical appointments in Wagga Wagga, enabling families to stay together. Hospitals or specialists. The house has four rooms, 2 of which have their own



bathroom and another two which share a bathroom. It is a tough job for Deborah and her staff but the house gives comfort for those away from home when they need somewhere to stay. More and more now the house is having nights where they are full and have to use the quiet

room or even the lounge room to cater for all the families.

The time each family stays at the house differs with some only spending one night and others using the house for months at a time. Ronald McDonald is staffed by volunteers both day and night as many times a family will need somewhere to stay after arriving in Wagga late at night.

Our usual donation of Tissues and toilet paper were well received and something the house can never have enough of.

Following the tour of the house some members headed to dinner at the Indian Restaurant down the road.
