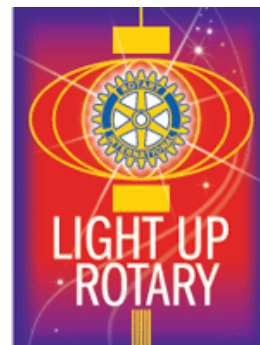

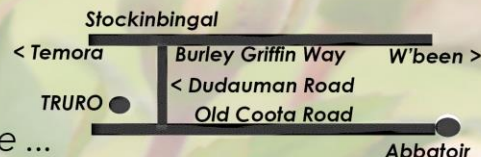

*"What happened Paddy?" she asks anxiously.*

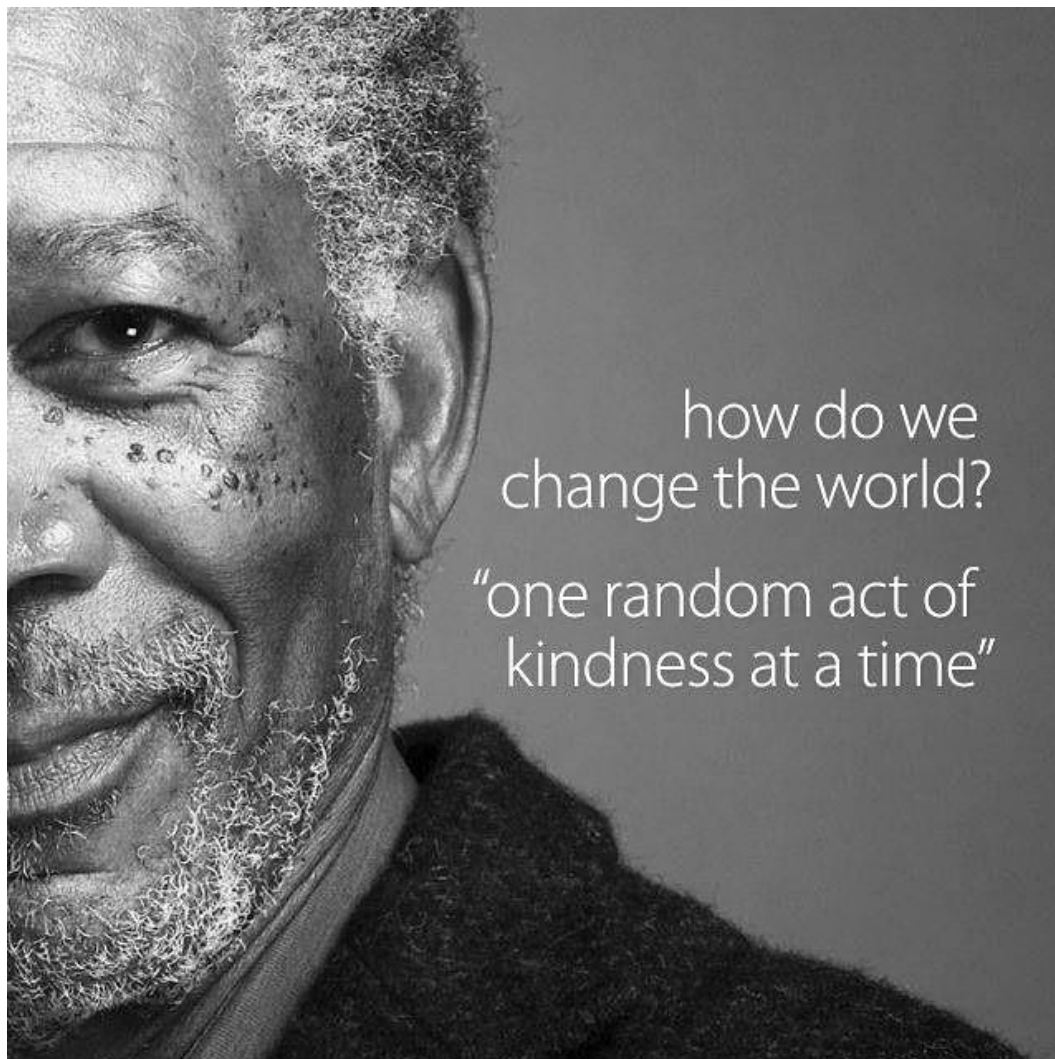
