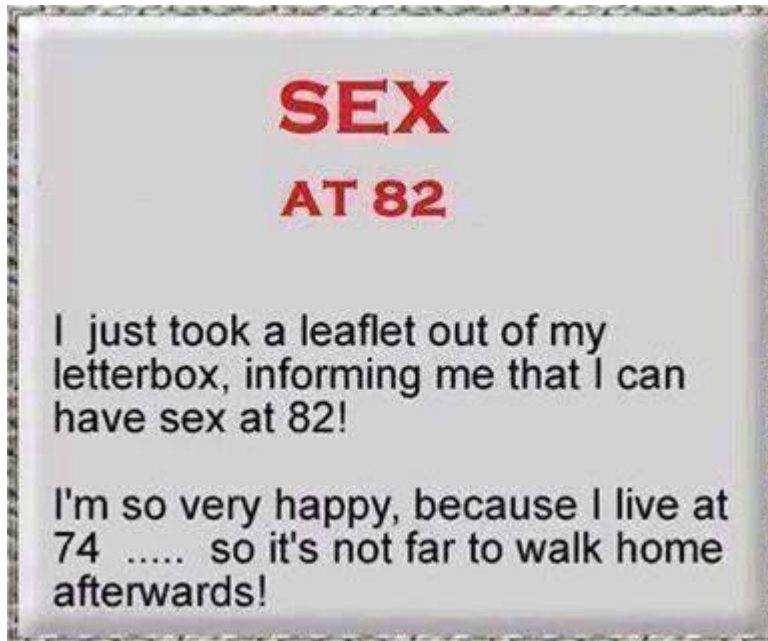


*Could this be the driving simulator the PCYC has been waiting for?*

This driving simulator is an attractive real world car design cockpit simulator. The system is compact and relatively easy to move around and transport. The design is smart and functional, with a real car cockpit layout and real world car controls. Three high resolution display panels gives the student a 180-210 degree horizontal field of view presented at a very high frame rate in HD. The operator has an integrated user interface whereby they can control assignments and assess student's progress. Lesson results can be printed off on the integrally fitted laser printer



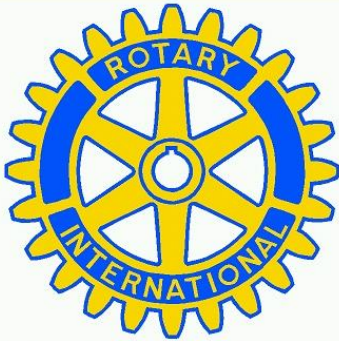
