

The Science and Engineering team from Henri Lawson High School did it again.



Students from the Henry Lawson High School qualified for the State final of the Science and Engineering Challenge for the 5<sup>th</sup> year in a row. After finishing first at the regional Challenge held earlier this year in Young (in which 7 high schools competed and which was organised by our Club and many other volunteers), they had to wait for the results of other regional Challenges to see whether their score was good enough to qualify for the State final – and it was! The State final will be held in late August at Newcastle University.
