# Notes on Junee Rotary Club Assembly 2<sup>nd</sup> July 2014.

#### General Business.

Peter Commens reported that he had been to speak to the Career's Advisor at Junee High School about the idea of running mock interviews for students wanting to join the work force. She told him that the school already had such a program but quite often it is difficult to attract people willing to be the interviewers. Peter said we would have members willing to fill that role if asked.

Stuart Robilliard reported that he had gone to a meeting with Darby Asmus, also at the High School, about providing a roof over the bbq area. Unfortunately there was no representative from the Junee Correctional Centre present so the meeting has been delayed to a later date (as yet unspecified).

#### Member Satisfaction Questionnaire.

The assembly then considered the results of the Member Satisfaction Questionnaire that had been distributed to members some weeks ago. Eleven completed questionnaires were handed in and Neil McKenzie had collated the answers and handed out hard copies of the results. The spreadsheet showing the collated information will be sent out with the next weekly bulletin.

All respondents felt welcome in our Club and all felt comfortable speaking with Club leaders.

The responses to the questions of member development showed an obvious area needing improvement. Member orientation and education also has room to improve. The assembly came up with suggestions to improve both these areas as follows;

At one meeting each month have a presentation by one of the Club members or a visiting Rotarian on a particular part of Rotary Service. Any Club member doing some

information gathering to bring to a meeting would become quite well informed on the selected topic.

The weekly bulletins of other Clubs in Group 5 will be sent on to all members in our Club so that we can learn what other Clubs are doing and how they do it. The bulletins from one other Club will be circulated each for a month and then another Club will feature for a month.

There was strong support for the present level of fund raising conducted by the Club.

There was discussion about the number of guest speakers who come to our meetings and the number of vocational visits we have. The consensus reached was two meetings per month was the best balance for guest speakers versus other activities and that one vocational visit per quarter would be best.

It is with regret that I advise that Jean Simpson passed away on Wednesday evening 18 June. At Jean's request there will be a private service at the Orange Crematorium.




