<u>SERGEANT-AT-ARMS:</u> David 'the Dragon' Brady took to his first fine session like a duck to water: All those who hadn't been fined by him before.

Those who had attended at least one of the many events in Wagga over last weekend. Football teams that won, and lost.

There were many other fines that realised a new record for a weekly meeting. Every person was fined at least once as the total of \$97.30 indicated.

GUEST SPEAKER: Mrs Carolyn DeWaegeneire was introduced by Tim Stait.

Carolyn then recounted a story of absolute horror, shock and disgust. In 2002 she went into



hospital in August of that year to have a small lesion removed from her genital area.

She awoke to find that her clitoris had been removed; she was unable to tell anyone for two years.

In 2007 an amount of money was awarded but she never received a cent. Due to the doctor stating he was bankrupt, and that he had no insurance policy that was current. She then made a report to Bega Police in 2008 and a taskforce of fifteen Detectives weas set up to investigated the former Bega gynaecologist. In July of that year the Doctor was found guilty of, with intent, inflicting grievous bodily harm. The doctor was jailed for three and a half years with a minimum of two years to serve, and appealed the sentence. In march 2011, a panel of twelve jurors, after listening to three-and-a-half weeks of evidence found the Doctor guilty as charged:

maliciously causing grievous bodily harm, with intent. This offence carries a maximum of 25 years. However a learned Judge on the 1^{st} July, 2011 disagreed with the jury's verdict and imposed a one year non-parole custodial sentence for 'Grievous Bodily Harm'.

"The issue here is not what happened to me as a result of a medical procedure, but that the wisdom and consideration of twelve jurors can be dismissed by one presiding judge", said Carolyn.

Carolyn was thanked for her heart rending and powerful presentation by **Noelene Hogan** and more than usual applause and appreciation was expressed by Sunrise members
