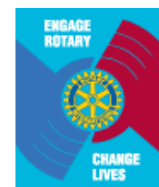

Darryl & Dorrice Lamotte

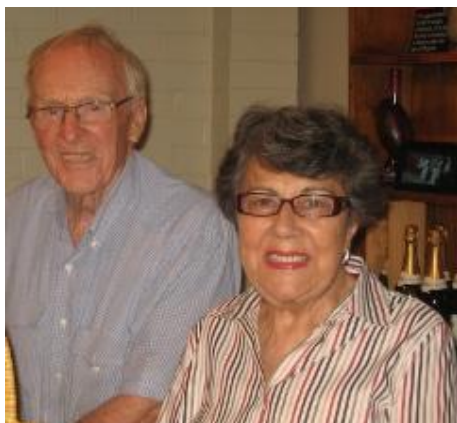
