

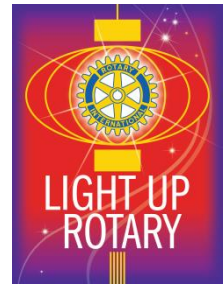

The aim of the Kids Right2see program is early detection and prevention of childhood eye disorders.

Prof Kanagasingam said one in four school-age children had a vision problem but might not have been diagnosed. If left untreated, such problems could affect learning ability, behaviour, personality and personal achievement, including academic, music and sporting performance.

The free eye checks are being coordinated by the Rotary Club of Freshwater Bay.
