

GUEST SPEAKER – MICHAEL SLINGER INTRODUCED KATRINA BROWN FROM HEART KIDS

Katrina became involved width Heart Kids after returning to live in Wagga in recent years.

Katrina's son was born with heart disease which was diagnosed during prenatal screening. The family moved to Melbourne and Katrina was monitored there, and her son's birth there ensured his quick transfer to The Melbourne Childrens' Hospital for treatment. He has had major surgery after his birth, at 3 months of age, and will have more when he is 3-4 years old. When they visited the hospital at Christmas they were touched by the Christmas gifts that they were presented with by Heart Kids. Continued over page -

Heart Kids also assist families with travel and accommodation needs. The Melbourne Children's hospital treat over 3000 children with heart disorders per year. Heart disorders affect more than 1child in 100. Around 20 % of cases are genetic in origin, the other 80 % are of unknown cause. Heart conditions account for more than twice the deaths of childhood cancers.

Katrina is Heart Kids Riverina representative for NSW. The organisation is dedicated to children's heart disease, and is not government funded. They offer support to other parents of children with heart disorders. There are a lot of local families, with 20 to 25 families in Wagga Wagga. Heart Kids has spent over \$1.3 million on research into prevention and treatment of genetic causes, and into early detection by screening. Thanks to research and technology it is getting better to diagnose and treat, and children can now live longer and better lives. Heart Kids aims to inform people through fundraising events. Katrina's husband is coordinating the Tour de Ticker. A cycle ride of over 670km in 5 days. There are 15 local riders who have sponsorship of over \$30,000.
