

<u>Mexico</u>.

Nuevo Laredo is a city located in the Municipality of Nuevo Laredo in the Mexican State of Tamaulipas. The city lies on the banks of the Rio Grande across from the US city of Laredo Texas. The city has a population of 375,000. The city is connected to the US by 3 bridges which handle 8500 trucks per day. Because of the relative cheap labour large scale manufacturing is carried out for the US market. The city is both larger and younger than the US counterpart. After the 1847 war between the US and Mexico the area was divided up and 17 families elected to move to Mexico where they settled is now Nuevo Laredo. The Rotary Club of Nuevo Laredo was formed in 1944, has 23 members and meets at 1:30 on Mondays at the Crowne Plaza. The President is Rafael Baldomero Garcia Ramirez and the Secretary is Carlos A Alvarez.
