Malcolm Robertson gave a Rotary Information session about Rotary in Germany duing the Nazi years.

In 1933 the Nazi party considered Rotary could offer "an opportunity for party comrades". Clubs controlled by Nazis began excluding Jews and other non aryans. By 1937 half the members of Rotary clubs were Nazi party members. However, in January 1938, Rotary announced that the goals of the Nazi party and Rotary were incompatible.



Malcolm went on the outline the membership of 1.2 million and 34,000 clubs and noted that Rotary is the second largest service club behind Lions International. He said that Free Masons had 6 million members.
