MOUNTAINS OF THE MOON is a World AIDS Day mountain climb led by Rotarian and RFFA Board Member, John Glassford, to help the orphans and vulnerable children in Africa. On this forthcoming December 1st, John will lead a team of adventurers to climb the Rwenzoris in Uganda / East Africa (commonly referred to as Mountains of the Moon). John, who was born and raised in Kenya and later migrated to Australia, is a Rotarian in his mid-60's, and clearly believes in this cause of helping the kids — or he wouldn't be making this difficult climb!!

This exciting and unique fundraiser on World AIDS Day will provide for the care, support and education of the vulnerable children of AIDS at three centers: the Bishop Masereka's Medical Centre in Kasese, Uganda; Operation Medical Hope, Hout Bay, South Africa; and the School of St. Jude's Moshono, Tanzania.

You or your Rotary Club can sponsor these Rotarian climbers for as little as:
