GRENADA: HURRICANE BERYL



Our emergency shelter aid is supporting thousands of people on the islands of Carriacou and Petite Martinique whose homes were flattened by powerful winds and torrential rain.

We have now completed distributions of aid items, supporting hundreds of island families whose homes were destroyed. Rotary District 7030 has provided invaluable networking with local communities and disaster management agencies, and assisted with damage assessments.



Our deployed team was supported with the distribution of aid and erection of tents by local communities and volunteers from Rotary, LDSC, and the local authority NaDMA who have all been provided with the necessary training.

The emergency aid we used for this response was from our warehouse in Panama.

In other disasters, heavy duty tarpaulins, ropes and nails are needed to create emergency shelter or to patch-up damaged buildings.

We know that a home is much more than bricks and mortar or tarpaulin and tent pegs. That's why we also offer other aid items that are essential for survival like water carriers and kitchen sets.
